Definition (Anderson & Krathwohl)

Understanding: Constructing meaning from different types of function be they written or graphic.

Key Verbs (Bloom's Digital Taxonomy)

Interpreting, Summarising, Inferring, Paraphrasing, Classifying, Comparing, Explaining, Exemplifying, Advanced searches, Boolean searches, Blog journalling, Twittering, Categorising and tagging, Commenting, Annotating, Subscribing

Possible Activities (Bloom's Digital Taxonomy)

Summary (Word Processing, Mind map, web publishing, Simple DTP products – blog journals & simple page construction collaborative documents, wiki)

Explanation (Word Processing, Mind map, web publishing, simple DTP Products – blog journals & simple page construction collaborative documents, wiki)

Show and tell (Word Processing, presentation – online & desktop based, graphics, audio tools - audacity sound recorder & podcasting tools, video tools, Mind map)

Advanced and boolean searches - advanced search features - google etc.

Blog journalling - bloglines, blogger etc.

Diary/Journal (blogging, Myspaces, Bebo, facebook, bloglines, blogger, ning)

Categorising and tagging - Delicious etc.

Tagging, comments & annotating - -noticeboards, discussion boards, threaded discussions, adobe acrobat reader, blog readers, firefox, zotero

Subscribing – RSS aggregators e.g. bloglines, blogger etc., firefox extensions
