- All of us need to teach the academic language necessary to communicate (read, write, listen, and speak) in the content areas.

## Quick "How to" combine language and content objectives:

- Identify the content objective (topic)
- Choose a language function (for example: describe, analyze, compare, recite)
- Design instruction using support (strategy)
- Example: Describe in his/her own words and illustrate understanding of the first 10 amendments of the Constitution using cooperative groups and "Piece o' Pizza"
- Example: Orally compare and contrast urban and rural communities using Strategy #3: Zoom In (See-Think-Wonder) and sentence starters.
